Work Session

Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 8:33 a.m. by Chair Marion.

Non-Public Session per RSA 91-A:3 (I) Legal

System operations and supply update – Odd/Even irrigation schedule

Administrator Goetz ordered odd/even signs that will be posted throughout town, similar to last year. According to Superintendent Jones, compliance appears to be pretty good and water demands haven't really picked up too much. Likely to happen around the 4th of July.

Equipment purchase through LSLI Grant

Administrator Jones is getting quotes for additional equipment that the District can purchase through the LSLI Grant program. This equipment will be utilized for the service line investigations. He will bring that information forward at a subsequent district meeting.

Rye Hazard Mitigation Plan Update

Administrator Goetz attended the town of Rye's Hazard Mitigation Plan Update meeting at Town Hall. This update occurs every five years. The district noted that part of the contingency planning in the event of a major emergency is to have interconnections with adjacent systems. The district already has one with the City of Portsmouth. A second one with Aquarion would actually create interconnections of water system all the way from Seabrook to Newington, a great regional benefit. Administrator Goetz will prepare a memo that can be submitted with this

report to put the construction of the Rye/Aquarion interconnection on the list of projects that could be funded through this program.

Rate Study continuation – in preparation of 2027 budget

Administrator Goetz will be meeting with Underwood Engineers soon to have them put together a scope of work for the next round of rate increases. A major focus will be to start raising rates prior to the first payment for the water treatment facility loan, which will start in 2030.
